The club is also an opportunity for members to share interests, hobbies, and develop friendships and a sense of unity with other Jewish girls their age. The club leader will infuse each club meeting with positive energy and a unique connection to Jewish concepts and ancestry. Joining the Bat Mitzvah Club will provide your daughter with Jewish pride, confidence and knowledge.

The BMC is open to girls in 6th and 7th grades. Girls joining as 7th graders need not have joined the prior year. This year's curriculum will focus on learning about the Jewish lifecycle. Our projects and activities will center around giving to our community. At this stage the girls know the importance of thinking of others and the good feeling they are rewarded with when they have the opportunity to give. If you or your daughter feels close to a cause/charity that you would like to help in some way (other than actual fundraising) please let us know and we will try to incorporate it into our curriculum.

It is an exciting curriculum, filled with beautiful Jewish traditions and fascinating discussions. Throughout the year members will gain a strong sense of being part of our vibrant heritage, past and present.
